Recruitment for filling up the vacancies remained unfilled from Constable (General Duty)-2022 recruitment in **Group ‘C’**, for **Male and Female Indian citizens** belonging to **BORDER DISTRICTS OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH** in the ITBP as mentioned at para 4 (a), will be carried out through **OPEN RALLY SYSTEM**. The post has All India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules.

2. PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES:-

a) Pay Level-3 (Rs. 21,700-69,100)

b) Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. They will be covered under new restructured defined contributory pension scheme.

3. A candidate appearing for the test should mention/intimate if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him in any police station/Hon’ble court/any criminal case decided against him by court of law.

Note: -

- i) 10% of the vacancies in each category are reserved for Ex-Servicemen. In case the vacancy reserved for Ex-servicemen, remain unfilled due to non-availability of eligible or qualified candidates, the same shall be filled by candidates from non-ex-servicemen category.
- ii) The posts are temporary but likely to become permanent.
- iii) The candidates should report for recruitment at the centres and on the dates mentioned against their Districts. Candidate can register for recruitment rally at respective centres on any day of the Rally till completion of recruitment at that particular centre.
- iv) Various tests for this recruitment rally shall be conducted in continuation with each others as mentioned at **para-7** subject to qualifying each test by the candidate.

5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) **AGE:** – Between 18 to 23 Years (**Cut off date for determining the age will be 1st August 2023**).

Note:-

- (a) The upper age limit is relaxable for SC, ST, Ex-Servicemen and other categories of persons in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government.
- (b) Candidates should note that only Date of Birth as recorded in the Matriculation Certificate available on the date of submission of

application will be accepted for determining the age and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.

- (c) Candidates who wish to be considered against vacancies reserved or seek age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the competent authority, in the prescribed format when such certificate is sought by the Recruitment Board. Otherwise, their claim for SC/ST status will not be entertained and their candidature/applications will be considered under General (UR) category. The formats of the certificates are annexed. Certificates obtained in any other format will not be accepted.
- (d) Crucial date for claiming SC/ ST/EWS status will be 31/08/2023.
- (e) The reservation for EWS to those candidates who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs will be admissible as per Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt(Res) dated 31.01.2019 and its amendment issued by the Central Government from time to time.
- (f) Age relaxation available to different category of eligible candidates. Categories for which age relaxation is granted are as under:-

- (g) Break between Army Service and re-employment should not exceed 2 years.

(c) An colour blind person will not be eligible for appointment. If at any stage of service career the person is found to be colour blind, he will be boarded out as per 'SHAPE' policy in vogue.

(d) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

(e) **Tattoos: -**

(a) Content: Being a secular country, the religious sentiments of our countrymen are to be respected and thus, tattoos depicting religious symbol or figures and the name, as followed in Indian Army are to be permitted.

(b) Location: Tattoos marked on traditional sites of the body like inner aspect of forearm but only left forearm, being non saluting limb and dorsum of the hands are to be allowed.

(c) Size: Size must be less than $\frac{1}{4}$ of the particular part (Elbow or Hand) of the body.

(v) **APPLICATION FEE** :The candidates belonging to General, EWS and OBC categories will be required to pay Rs 100/- (Non refundable), as application fee in form of IPO or Bank/Demand Draft. Bank/Demand Draft and IPO should be prepared in favour of INSPECTOR GENERAL, (NE) FRONTIER, ITB POLICE, Itanagar (Arunachal Pradesh) and enclosed with application form. No fee will be charged from Female, SC/ST & Ex-servicemen candidates.

6. **DOCUMENTS/CERTIFICATES REQUIRED TO BE BROUGHT AT THE TIME OF RECRUITMENT TEST :-**

(a) The eligible and willing candidates should report at the designated recruitment centre on given date and time allotted for their district with duly filled application form, Admit Card and Registration Slip (Annexure-I, II & VI). Following documents shall be required to be produced in original by the candidate who has qualified Physical Standard Test, in original and one attested photocopy, for verification to the Recruitment Board, just after PST and at the time of detailed medical examination as well.

- (i) Educational Certificate.
- (ii) Date of birth certificate (Matriculation or 10th Class certificate) as **proof of date of birth.**
- (iii) Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Certificate/EWS certificate (if belonging to any of these categories) issued by an authority not lower than Tehsildar or SDM.

Note:- SC/ST certificate must be in prescribed proforma as attached at Annexure –‘III’ and EWS certificate in Annexure-‘V’.

- (iv) Domicile Certificate/ Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC) issued by the competent authority.
 - (v) Discharge certificate for Ex-Servicemen.
 - (vi) “**No Objection Certificate**” in case persons serving in Govt./Semi Govt. organization.
 - (vii) Valid NCC Certificate, if applicable.
 - (viii) An IPO/DD/BD for Rs. 100/- (Rs Hundred only) as application fee by General, EWS and OBC category Male candidates.
- (b) Four latest passport size photograph should be brought at the time of recruitment tests.

7. **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The eligible candidates with duly filled up application form should report at the designated recruitment Centre on dates mentioned in Para-4 (b).The Candidates who report at the designated recruitment Centers on the given date and time will be put through the selection process consisting of following stages:-

- a) **Registration:** Candidates can report on any of the day between 05/10/2023 to 08/10/2023 from 0700 Hrs to 1600 Hrs at ITBP recruitment centre mentioned against his/her District for registration. For registration a candidate is required to bring a duly filled up application (Annexure-I), Admit card (Annexure-II) and Registration Slip (Annexure-VI) with them.

Copies of these Forms are also available on ITBP recruitment website i.e. www.recruitment.itbpolice.nic.in. **Once** the duly filled in correct Form is submitted by the candidate he/she will be given a date and time on which he/she will be required to appear at respective ITBP recruitment centre for PET/PST and documentation.

- b) **Race (PET):** After registration, the candidates will be subjected to race as per given below:-

For Male- 5 kilometers race to be completed within 24 minutes.

For Female- 1.6 kilometers race to be completed within 8.30 minutes.

- (i) No marks will be awarded for this test and PET shall be qualifying in nature. Candidates are required to qualify each event of PET. Candidates who do not qualify shall be eliminated.
- (ii) There is no provision of appeal against PET events.
- (iii) On reporting of female candidates for PET (Physical Efficiency Test)/PST (Physical Standard Test), a self-declaration indicating about her pregnancy status shall be submitted. In case, if she declares that she is not pregnant then, she may be allowed to participate in the PET/PST. In case of false declaration, all the risk for undergoing PST/PET will be of her own.
- (iv) If the female candidate declares that she is pregnant before PET/PST, then a confirmatory pregnancy test to be done and in case she is found to be pregnant, irrespective of duration of pregnancy, she may be declared temporary unfit and her appointment shall be held in abeyance until the confinement is over. The vacancy against which a women candidate was selected will be kept reserved for her. She will be re-examined for PET/PST six weeks after the date of confinement, subject to the production of the medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical practitioner. If she is found fit, she may be appointed to the post kept reserved for and allow the benefits of seniority in accordance with the instructions of the Government, as amended from time to time. In case female candidate is found negative for pregnancy, she may be allowed to participate in the PST/PET." However, such female candidates who are declared temporary unfit will have to appear and qualify PET/PST, Written Examination, Documentation and DME/RME and has to secure place in final selection list of respective category.

- c) **Physical Standard Test(PST):** Candidates who qualify the PET will be screened for Height, Chest (For males only) and Weight measurements. Those who do not meet the required physical measurements as applicable will be eliminated at this stage. The candidates who are declared not qualified in physical standard test i.e. height/chest (as applicable) may prefer an appeal on same day, if they so desire, to the appellate authority nominated for the centre. The decision of the Appellate Authority will be final and no further appeal or representation in this regard will be entertained thereafter.

Ex-servicemen will have to appear in PET/ PST for recording of measurement of height, chest and weight only. There is total relaxation in PST/PET for Ex-serviceman. PET will not be held for these Ex-servicemen candidates. However, they will have to qualify the written examination, document verification and medical examination.

- d) **Documentation:** The candidates who qualify in the Physical standard Test will be required to produce all relevant documents, in original only, as mentioned in para 6 above.
- e) **Biometric identification:** Finger impression in respect of Documentation qualified candidates will be captured immediately and will be verified on subsequent recruitment tests to avoid impersonation.
- f) **Written Test (100 Marks):**
- (i) The candidates who qualify the Documentation stage will be required to appear in a written test.
- (ii) NON-OMR based multiple choice question paper will be set **(Bilingual i.e. in Hindi & English)** to assess the General Intelligence and Reasoning/General Knowledge and General Awareness, Elementary Mathematics and to test basic knowledge of candidate in English/Hindi. The question paper will carry 100 objective types multiple choice questions and would carry 100 marks. There will be no negative marking.
- (iii) Minimum qualifying marks for General- 25%, EWS-20% and for SC/ST category candidates is 20%.
- (iv) Incentive to NCC Certificate Holders: The incentive to 'NCC Certificate' holders will be granted at the following scales:

Certificate Category	Incentive/Bonus marks
NCC 'C' Certificate	5% of the maximum marks of the examination
NCC 'B' Certificate	3% of the maximum marks of the examination
NCC 'A' Certificate	2% of the maximum marks of the examination

1. The benefit of incentive/Bonus marks will only be provided to a candidate who has opted for bonus marks/ incentive for 'NCC certificate' in his/her recruitment application.
2. The benefit to NCC Certificate Holder will be confirmed only on production of the original certificate supporting their claims at the time of document verification.
3. However, till the verification of NCC Certificate, bonus marks will be awarded provisionally as per the claim of candidate in the application form.
4. The crucial date for this purpose will be 31/08/203.
5. This benefit is not available for Ex-servicemen

f) **Merit Lists:** Merit lists will be drawn separately in respect of vacancies as given at **para-4 (a)** in each category namely, UR, SC, ST, EWS and Ex-servicemen, on the basis of marks obtained in the written test. On the basis of this merit list, the candidates will be shortlisted for detailed medical examination.

g) **RESOLUTION OF TIE CASES**

- a) The tie cases will be resolved as the candidate older in age gets preference.
- b) If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical (English) order of names i.e. a candidate whose name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.

h) **Detailed Medical Examination:-** The Detailed Medical Examination(DME) of the shortlisted candidates will be conducted in terms of Uniform Guidelines for Recruitment Medical Examination for GOs and NGOs in CAPFs and AR issued vide MHA U.O. No. A.VI-1/2014- Rectt (SSB) dated 20.05.2015 and as amended from time to time by the Government.

l) **Appeal against Detailed Medical Examination**

- (i) All candidates declared unfit during Detailed Medical Examination (DME) will be allowed to undergo Review Medical Examination (RME), provided they give their written consent by appending their signature on the intimation indicating the reasons for being unfit as per Annexure-‘VII’.
- (ii) The candidates who have been declared unfit in DME will be briefed about the procedure for submission of their consent for RME at the venue.
- (iii) The RME of candidates will be conducted in continuation of DME preferably on the next day of DME. The consent for RME as per Annexure-‘VII’ duly signed by the candidate should be submitted within 24 hours after he/she is informed of her unfitness in DME.
- (iv) The decision of ITBP Board of Medical Officers shall be final for declaring a candidate Fit or Unfit in DME/RME.

8. Candidates belonging to physically handicapped category are not eligible for this Recruitment Rally.

9. All disputes and differences, if any, will be subject to jurisdiction of Delhi only.

10. Candidates should come duly prepared for 4-5 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. The candidates shall have to bring with them pen/pencil, ink and clip board when called for written test. The Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the Recruitment process. **No TA/DA will be admissible.**

11. **General Instructions for candidates:-**

(1) If candidates are found to indulge at any stage in any of the malpractices listed below during the conduct of recruitment or thereafter, their candidature for this recruitment will be cancelled:-

- (a) Taking away any Examination related material such as Question Paper, Answer Sheet(s), Rough Sheets etc. from the examination hall or passing it on to unauthorized persons during the conduct of examination.
- (b) Leaving the Examination venue without prior permission of the invigilator.
- (c) Assault, use of force, causing bodily harm, misbehaving, intimidating or threatening in any manner with the recruitment functionaries i.e. Supervisor, Invigilator or ITBPF Officers/personnel etc.
- (d) Obstruct the conduct of recruitment/ instigate other candidates not to participate in recruitment.
- (e) Making statements which are incorrect or false, suppressing material information, submitting fabricated documents, etc.
- (f) Obtaining support/ influence for his/ her candidature by any irregular or improper means in connection with his/ her candidature.
- (g) Possession of Mobile Phone in either 'switched on' or 'switched off' mode.
- (h) A person who is associated with the conduct of the recruitment in any manner, whatsoever.
- (i) Damaging recruitment related infrastructure/ equipments.
- (j) Appearing in the Exam with forged Admit Card, identity proof, etc.
- (k) Possession of fire arms/ lethal weapons during the examination.
- (l) Threatening/ intimidating examination functionaries with weapons/ fire arms.
- (m) Using unfair means in the examination hall like copying from unauthorized sources such as written material on any paper or body parts, etc.
- (n) Possession of Bluetooth Devices, spy cameras, and any other electronic gadgets in the examination hall.
- (o) Impersonate/ Procuring impersonation by any person.
- (p) Taking snapshots, making videos of question papers or examination material, labs, recruitment etc.

(2) All candidates who have been called for PET, PST will bring a clear and legible print out of the duly filled application form for purpose of registration else they will not be permitted to participate in recruitment venue. The print out will be retained by ITBP staff for office use.

(3) Candidates are to ensure to keep sufficient number of same passport size photos used by them in filling the application form. The candidates are also advised to bring same passport size photos submitted with application form at all stages of recruitment.

- (4) Government Servants should submit in original "No Objection Certificate" from their employer at the time of documentation else their candidature will be rejected.
- (5) Verification of original documents will be conducted before Detailed Medical Examination, therefore candidates are advised to confirm their eligibility in all respects to avoid any disappointment at later stage.
- (6) Admit card to the eligible candidates will be issued by mentioning date and venue. Candidates are required to appear for recruitment on the date and time given in the Admit Card. Candidate will also be contacted through e-mail or SMS on their registered e-mail ID and Mobile Numbers for recruitment related information/update, if any. Therefore, candidates should provide genuine and functional e-mail ID and Mobile number at the time of filling application form. ITBP will not be responsible in case of non receipt of admit card due to any reasons.
- (7) ITBP shall not be responsible for any damage/injury to the individual sustained during the course of recruitment process.
- (8) Candidates are advised to be beware of touts or not to fall prey to the unscrupulous elements. Recruitment in ITBP is totally transparent, fair and purely on the basis of performance of the aspirants. No candidate is required to pay any money in cash or otherwise, for recruitment in ITBPF. If someone approaches any candidate asks for money or any other favour, they may report the matter to the recruitment board or the local police.
- (9) Candidates shall be required to serve in the Force for a minimum period of 10 years. If any person after joining the service wants to resign from the service before the expiry of 10 years, he/she is required to refund a sum equal to three months' pay and allowances attached to the post or the cost of training imparted to him/her by the Force, whichever is higher.
- (10) Selected candidates shall have to undergo Basic Training and such other courses as prescribed in the Force from time to time.
- (11) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
